

INDIVIDUAL ACCESS SERVICES (IAS) CONSENT

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 14, 2026

This consent allows you to enroll in and use the Individual Access Services ("**IAS**") provided by Prolaio, Inc. ("**Prolaio**," "**we**," "**us**," or "**our**") through our Trusted Exchange Framework and Common Agreement ("**TEFCA**") connection ("**IAS Consent**"). IAS enables you to request and receive copies of your electronic health information from participating health care providers and others through TEFCA.

By signing below, selecting "I Agree," enrolling in IAS, or otherwise accessing or using our IAS, you acknowledge that you have read, understand, and agree to this IAS Consent and our TEFCA Privacy and Security Notice ("TEFCA Notice"). If you do not agree to this IAS Consent or the TEFCA Notice, you may not enroll in, access, or use our IAS.

CONSENT TO USE INDIVIDUAL ACCESS SERVICES

You are giving your express, documented, and informed consent for Prolaio to access, retrieve, receive, transmit, use, disclose, and exchange copies of your Individually Identifiable Information through our TEFCA connection for the purposes of: (a) providing IAS to you at your request and direction; (b) complying with applicable legal and regulatory requirements; and (c) performing other functions reasonably necessary for us to provide IAS to you as described in TEFCA Notice.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE TEFCA PRIVACY AND SECURITY NOTICE (TEFCA NOTICE)

You acknowledge that you have received, reviewed, and agree to the TEFCA Notice, which is incorporated herein by reference. You understand that the TEFCA Notice describes how your Individually Identifiable Information is accessed, used, disclosed, secured, and retained in connection with IAS through our TEFCA connection. Individually Identifiable Information means information that identifies you, or that someone could reasonably use to identify you.

YOUR RIGHTS AND CHOICES REGARDING YOUR INFORMATION

You have the following rights with respect to the Individually Identifiable Information we maintain in connection with your use of IAS:

- **Right to Access.** You may access and view the Individually Identifiable Information we maintain in connection with your use of IAS.
- **Right to Export.** You may request an export of your Individually Identifiable Information in a machine-readable format, including the information necessary to interpret that format.
- **Right to Deletion.** You may request that we delete your Individually Identifiable Information, to the extent technically feasible and not prohibited by law. This right does not apply to audit logs or records we must keep for legal, contract, or policy

compliance.

- **Right to Be Notified of IAS Incidents.** If your Individually Identifiable Information is reasonably believed to have been affected by an IAS Incident, we will notify you as described in Section 7 (Your Rights) of the TEFCa Notice. An **"IAS Incident"** is a TEFCa Security Incident or a Breach of Unencrypted Individually Identifiable Information maintained by us.
- **Right to Revoke Consent.** You may revoke this IAS Consent at any time through our Platform or by contacting us as described below.

The procedures for exercising these rights are described in Section 7 (Your Rights) of our TEFCa Notice.

You may revoke your IAS consent at any time. To revoke:

 - Step 1: Log in to your Prolaio IAS Portal account and go to Profile tab
 - Step 2: Click on the "Remove My Info" at the bottom right of your profile page.
 - Step 3: You will be prompted to confirm your request. Once you confirm, click "Delete My Info". This process will direct Prolaio to delete all information housed within the platform AND to revoke Prolaio's authorization to request health information; or Email support@prolaio.com with your name, email address associated with your Prolaio IAS account, phone number, and a short description of what you want (access, export, deletion, or revocation of consent).

Revoking your IAS Consent does not affect actions we already took based on your prior consent. After you revoke, you will no longer be able to use IAS through our TEFCa connection. Revocation requests will be processed in accordance with applicable legal and technical requirements.
